

Chart 1: Adult Critical and Early Warning Reported Incidents

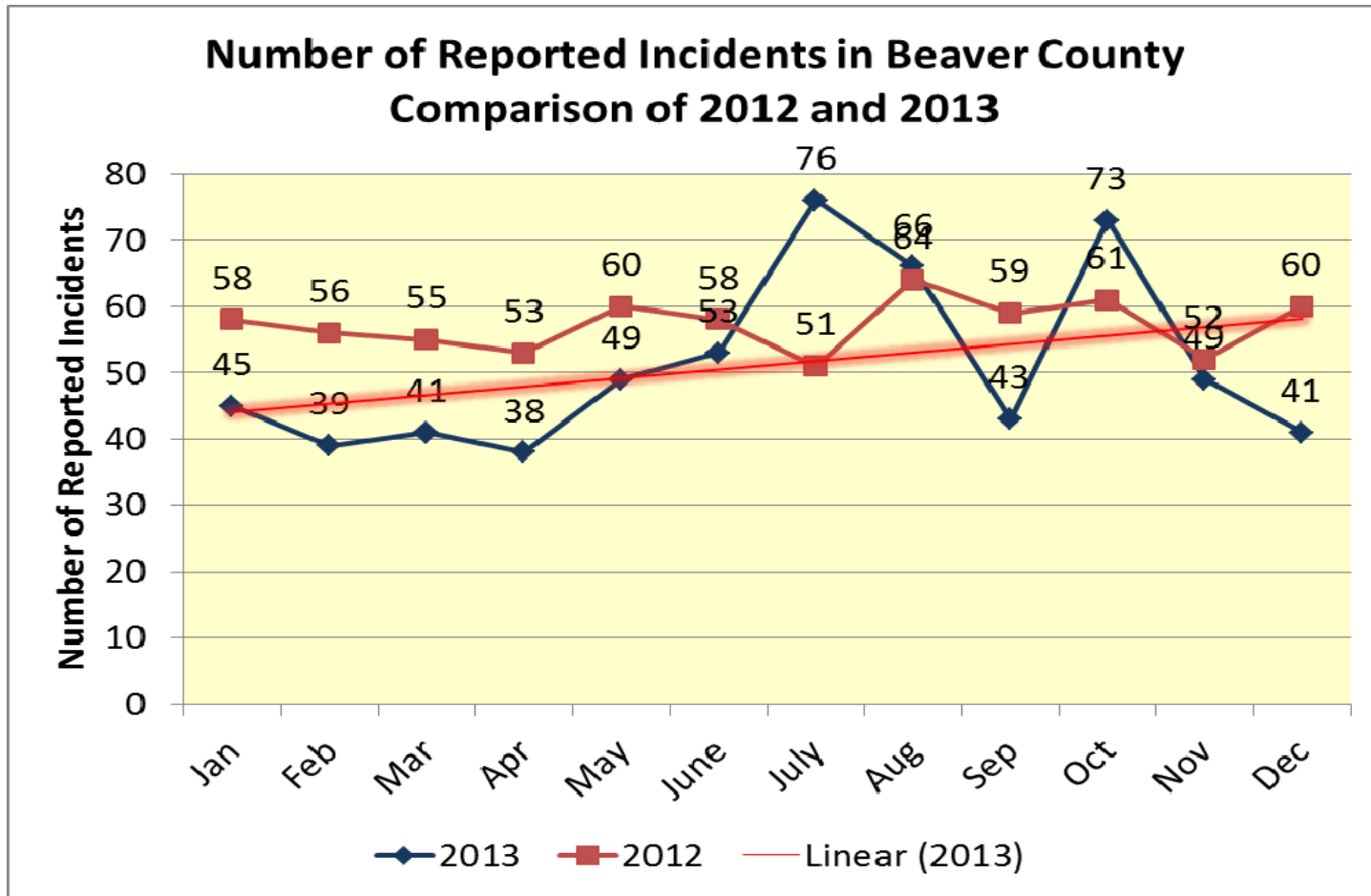
