Update on Enrollments & Review of Data

The purpose of the NOMS and ROSI instruments was explained for new members
We have a total of 49 enrollments to-date, and need 50 by the end of September. **UPDATE – HPW has
received the 50th enrollment**

HPW presented data coming from the 49 enrollments.

It was decided that HPW will present an overview of demographic data and ROSI results monthly at the QI meetings, and would put together more detailed results on a quarterly basis.

Darlene suggested adding questions to see if people are actively involved in recovery, such as WRAP, 12-step programs, support groups, etc. Holly brought up the possibility of a focus group to get this information.

The committee discussed using data from the CFST survey as well. Melissa brought a copy of the survey for HPW to review.

The committee continued discussing comparing data for those who receive more intensive services with those who receive fewer services.

Update on Core Values Survey

Holly explained the purpose of the survey for new members of the committee. HPW still needs a couple more consumers and/or family members to pilot the survey. The final survey will be sent out in October
