Selecting from these options may help you avoid a hospital stay.

Or, if necessary, <u>UPMC Beaver County Crisis</u> can help you facilitate a hospital admission:

- Call the 24-hour Crisis Telephone Hotline (above) at UPMC Beaver County Crisis.
 The Hotline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- Go to the Walk-In Center, also located at UPMC Beaver County Crisis in Beaver Falls.
 The Center is open between 8am and 5pm, 365 days per year.
- Request a team of clinicians from **Mobile Crisis Services**. They can meet with consumers in their home or in the community, Monday through Friday, from 9am to 7pm.
- Connect through Telehealth Services from 7am to 10pm, seven days a week.
- Just need to talk to someone? **WARMLINE Peers** are available from 6pm to 9pm, 365 days a year, including holidays and weekends at 724-775-9507.
- The least restrictive care is always preferred. But when further aid is needed,
 UPMC Beaver County Crisis can also facilitate referrals to community resources and other supports such as transportation to the hospital.
