Or, if necessary, UPMC Beaver County Crisis can help you facilitate  
a hospital admission:***

- Call the **24-hour Crisis Telephone Hotline** (above) at **UPMC Beaver County Crisis**. The Hotline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.
- Go to the **Walk-In Center**, also located at **UPMC Beaver County Crisis** in Beaver Falls. The Center is open between 8am and 5pm, 365 days per year.
- Request a team of clinicians from **Mobile Crisis Services**. They can meet with consumers in their home or in the community, Monday through Friday, from 9am to 7pm.
- Connect through **Telehealth Services** from 7am to 10pm, seven days a week.
- Just need to talk to someone? **WARMLINE Peers** are available from 6pm to 9pm, 365 days a year, including holidays and weekends at 724-775-9507.
- The least restrictive care is always preferred. But when further aid is needed, **UPMC Beaver County Crisis** can also facilitate referrals to community resources and other supports such as transportation to the hospital.
