Registering for Supports Coordination Services in Beaver County: A Checklist



Use this checklist to ensure you have the correct information and documentation to establish eligibility before applying.

- ID Diagnosis based on Full Scale IQ of 70 or below: A signed evaluation from a doctor or licensed clinician (i.e., licensed psychologist, developmental pediatrician, psychiatrist, licensed physician, licensed physician assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner) that certify an ID Diagnosis.
- Adaptive Functioning Assessment: Indication of substantial skill deficits in three or more areas (self care, receptive and expressive language, learning, mobility, self-direction, capacity of independent living) based on clinical data of either:
 - Vineland Adaptive Behavior Scales
 - Adaptive Behavior Assessment System (ABAS)
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card or Other Documentation of Citizenship Status
- Copy of MA Card and Other Insurance Cards if You are Also Covered by Private Insurance or Medicare
- Photo Identification
- Custody Documents (if applicable)

This checklist is a guide. You might be asked for other documents or information.

If you do not have documentation of an ID diagnosis or proof of adaptive functioning, see the reverse side for a resource list that will assist you in obtaining the necessary assessments.
